Dining Staff Appreciation: We are thinking about individual cards for the workers, which we will pass around for Residence Halls, with the help of the Hall Governments. Then we were debating whether or not we should use butcher paper or poster board for big poster of signatures that show thanks, and this would be hung outside the dining hall entrances/exits. Poster board would be more durable and last longer while butcher paper would be bigger in general. For the posters, we'll probably have someone get signatures throughout the week around dinner/lunch time.

Special Dinners: Candlelight Dinner is November 6th and the Harvest Dinner is November 18th.

Sunday Service: Looking in to the possibility of including a Sunday Dinner service. The most well received suggestion was to have Burge open in the morning (10 - 2) and Hillcrest open at night (2 - 7). The idea being that West Siders won't have to go out for a meal at night, and Burge can still have the fine selection of **Late Nite @ Burge**. The idea will be explored after a cost analysis.

Smart Choices Campaign: Suggestion to include a Wellness Wednesday each week to get students to think about making smart choices at meal times.

C-Store: The Dining Halls don't own the C-Store currently, but they are looking into it to extending the night hours when the stores come under Dining's supervision.

Someone suggested a suggestion box, others liked the idea of a comment card as a table tent, while some preferred using a Facebook group.
