This \$750 scholarship will be awarded to selected individuals who work either in the Burge Market Place, Hillcrest Market Place, or IMU Food Services and meet the required criteria. Two awards will be awarded per location, and the scholarship will be credited to the recipient's University account in the fall of 2009. Interested food service student employees should complete the application, sign, and submit either in person or via Campus or U.S. Mail to Julie Hamel, Burge Market Place, Iowa City, IA 52242-1214 by Friday, March 27, 2009. Attached to the application should be short answer responses to two questions and an essay response to one additional question (see application for details). Recipients will be selected by April 10th.

## CRITERIA

- **Applicant must be a student in good academic standing at The University of Iowa.**
- **Applicant must be a student working in either the Burge Market Place, Hillcrest Market Place, or Iowa Memorial Union Food Service.**
- **Applicant must have worked a minimum of 250 hours since date of employment cumulative at the time of the award.**

The responses to the short answer questions and the essay must be attached to this cover sheet. Content, spelling, and grammar are all extremely important.**
